

## Michael's Cocktail for Roses

- 2 Cups Epsom salts
- 4 Quarts \*Alfalfa tea
- 5 Tablespoons Miracle Grow for Roses
- 3 Tablespoons Fish / Seaweed Emulsion

Prepare fertilizer solution in a 5-gallon bucket. Add water to top of bucket.

## \*Alfalfa Tea recipe:

2 Cups Alfalfa Meal in a 5-gallon bucket; fill bucket with water

Allow solution to stand for four days before use. Water can be replenished three to four times before concentration is depleted.

## Michael's Yearly Care for Roses:

- Start spring pruning within a week of the forsythia bloom.
- Prune shrub roses, then floribundas, then hybrid teas.
- Old garden roses are only pruned lightly in spring as they bloom on old wood; they are generally pruned after their blooming period ends in spring/summer.
- Apply a spring feeding: 16/24/12 Granular Fertilizer, Bone Meal, and Greensand, within two weeks after spring pruning. Sprinkle a handful at base of each plant.
- Four weeks after pruning and application of spring feeding, apply liquid cocktail onto the base of each plant.

- To apply cocktail, pour a quart of solution onto each plant.
- After spring first flush is complete, provide the roses with another feeding of Granular Fertilizer and cocktail. Liquid cocktail to be applied every 2-3 weeks from first application until latter part of July.
- Beginning in August, the liquid cocktail should continue to be applied <u>but without Epsom</u>
   <u>salts</u>. Eliminate salts from the cocktail for 2-3 weeks until the end of August. No
   additional cocktail or feeding is required beyond this point.

All items can be purchased at Agway or a well-stocked nursery.
