It Happpend in the Garden.

Please see the photo of this green bean leaf. Sad to say, but tiny little bugs have been eating though out garden and almost killed this homegrown plant. Note the ugly leaves in the background. I thought this was something for the compost bin.

To fight back as best we can as our gardens are organic, we use a recipe from Hershey Gardens to spray on our plants for tiny mites, aphids and other creatures. This is non-toxic. They use this on their roses and in the children's area at their park. Spray it on after the afternoon sun has past and respray after rains.

1 tablespoon vinegar to 1 cup of water

Add 1 ½ tablespoons of baking soda

And 1 tablespoon of dish soap.. and 1 tablespoon of any cooking oil.
